

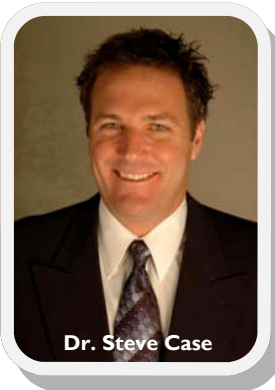
# Finding Jesus in the book of Revelation

How we live right now matters. It matters in little things as well as in big things. God's people keep following, and clinging to Jesus—no matter what happens.

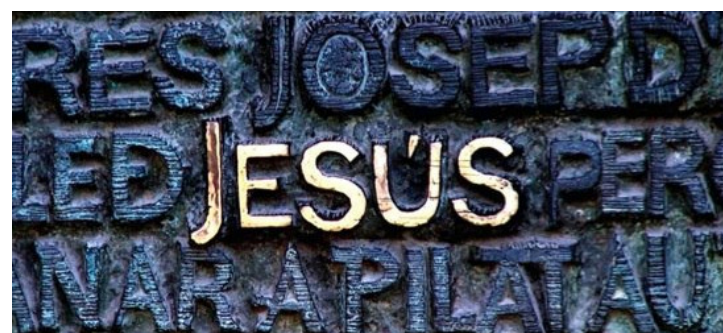
