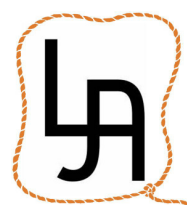

The Church Roof is being replaced. We have borrowed \$350,000 from the SWUC Revolving Fund. The monthly payment will be \$2,768 for 15 years! This revised our monthly budget from \$14,825 to \$17,253 Effective August 1, 2017 This debt could be erased with only 100 folks donating \$1/day for 15 years!
