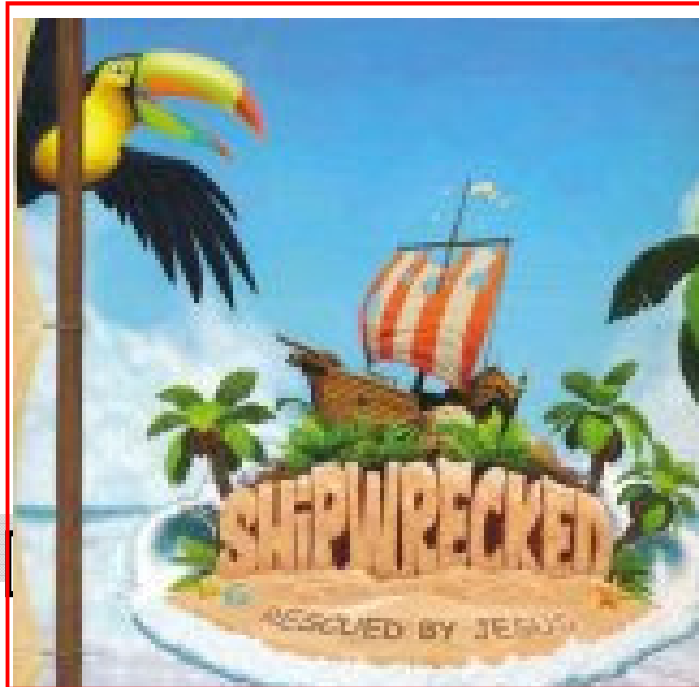
Today, we welcome

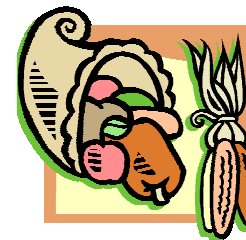

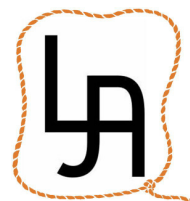
