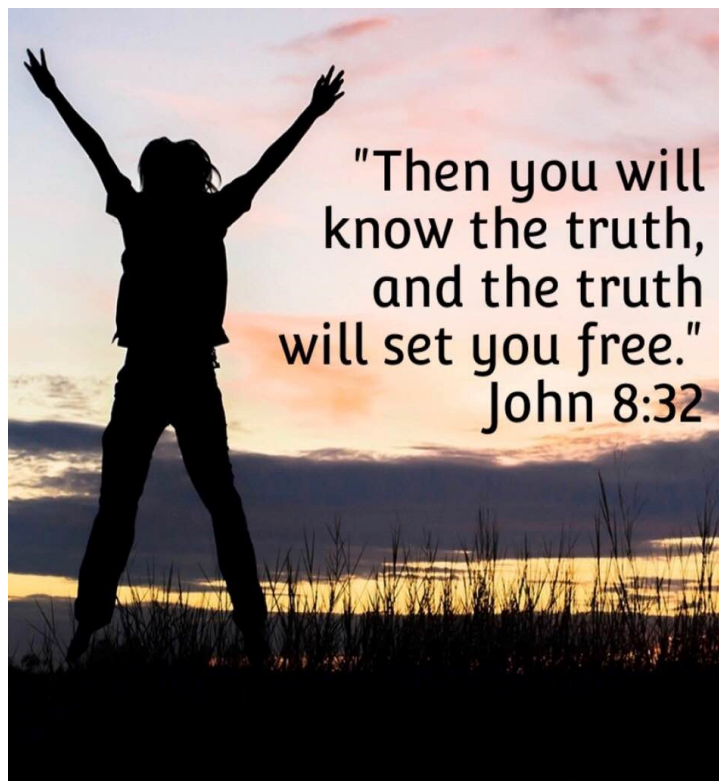
The Truth Shall Make You Free

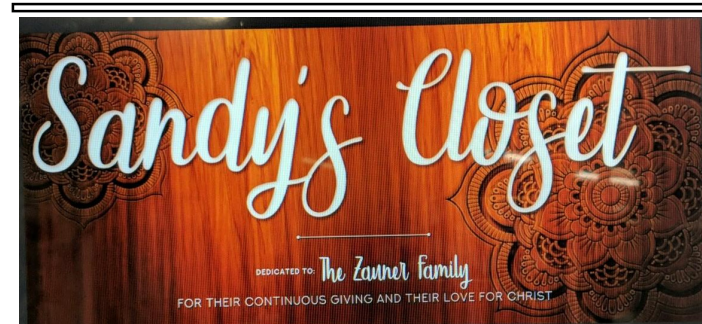

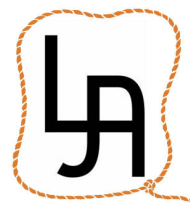
