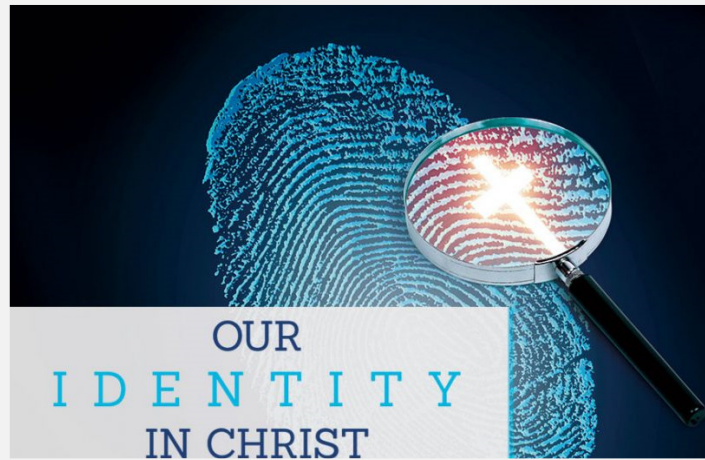


Identity Swap

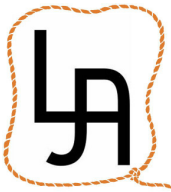
