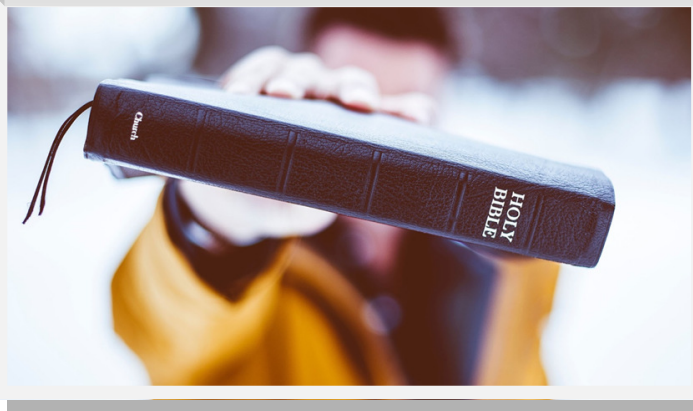


Validate This!

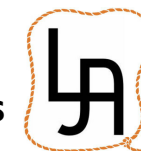

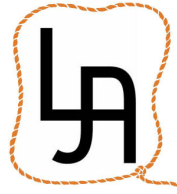
