This morning we extend a warm and cordial welcome to our distinguished guest speaker, **Dr. Bill Kilgore.**

Dr. Bill Kilgore completed his undergraduate work in 1977 at Columbia Union College in Takoma Park, MD; his Masters of Divinity from Andrews University in Berrien

Springs, MI in 1980; Doctor of Ministry degree from the Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, TX in 2003.

Dr. Kilgore served as a district pastor and as a Campus Chaplain before coming to Southwestern Adventist University in 1989. He taught Ethics, Greek, Homiletics, and Seventh-day Adventist Church History. During that 29 years, he led out each summer in the Field School of evangelism for Southwestern.

Dr. Kilgore's passion is preaching, assisting students on campus and church leaders in local congregations who believe God has called them to proclaim His love and His coming in these last days of earth's history.

Dr. Kilgore retired in July 2018 and in September 2018 he was granted the honorary academic rank of Professor Emeritus by the board of Southwestern Adventist University.

His wife, Leslie, was the school nurse for the Keene Independent School District for 27 years before retiring in 2016. They have two daughters, who with their families also live in the Keene area. Dr. Kilgore's message today is entitled:

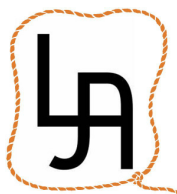
