## Social Distancing

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic  
Texas Governor Abbott

has issued Social Distancing/seating  
guidelines for meeting in church buildings

\* Keep at least two empty seats (or six foot separation)  
between parties in any row, except as follows:

\* **Two or more members of the same household can  
sit adjacent to one another, with two seats (or six  
foot separation) empty on either side.**

► Two individuals who are not members of the same  
household but who are attending together may sit  
adjacent to one another, with two seats (or six foot  
separation) empty on either side.

**\*Alternate rows between attendees  
(every other row must be left empty)**

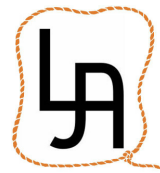
