In his letter to the believers in Colossae, the Apostle Paul touches on two very important realities in the life of a disciple. A disciple is one who is such a devoted follower of Jesus that his greatest desire is to share the good news of the gift of salvation through Jesus' death and resurrection with everyone.

What are these two important realities? First is the joyful celebration experienced by a person when they come to understand that Jesus loves them with all His heart and that His gift of salvation is theirs' for the accepting.

Everyone who has witnessed another individual come to faith in Jesus and begin to grasp the profound gift of His love and grace, can identify with the thrill of that experience. The overwhelming power of the kind of love that would go the cross for you and me is absolutely foreign to the way we look at love. There is no greater joy than to see the saving love of Jesus come into the heart of a brand-new believer through the power of the Gospel.

The second reality in the heart of a disciple is the desire to protect a new believer from everything through which false teachings may bring confusion. It is very important that the foundation of truth be well established. My prayer is that each of us will not only witness these realities as we share the love of Jesus with others but that we will find such joy in these experiences that we will be continually active in this sacred work.

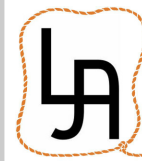

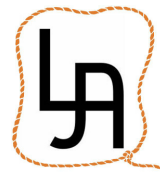
